Coney Island Prepares for Even More Thrills for the 2019 Season!

Coney Island, April 11, 2019 – After months of anticipation, Coney Island is ready to open it's attractions again for the 2019 Season.

At 11:15 AM, opening day ceremonies continue with a speaking program and press conference including remarks from local elected officials, followed by the Annual *Egg Cream Christening* at the **Coney Island Cyclone** presided over by Brooklyn Borough President Eric L. Adams.

Celebrating their 15th anniversary, the **Coney Island History Project** will be free of charge from 1:00 PM - 6:00 PM on April 14th. They invite visitors to take in some of our amazing history with their display of artifacts, photographs, maps, and films of Coney Island's colorful past.

Brooklyn's favorite baseball team, the **Brooklyn Cyclones** will throw their first home pitch of the 2019 season on June 14th, the team is currently offering pre-sale tickets with the code: BOARDWALK for the new season.

Every Friday and Saturday from June 28th to August 31st guests can enjoy some after hours fun at the **New York Aquarium** until 10PM. The Aquarium is home to hundreds of beautiful exotic fish and marine animals and features the newly opened exhibit Ocean Wonders: Sharks! that boasts a 57,000 square-foot exhibit showcasing sharks from around the globe.

For those looking to grab a bite to eat while enjoying the fun, all your favorite boardwalk concessions will be open this weekend as well. **Coney Cones**, **La Famiglia Pizzeria**, **Nathan's Famous**, **Paul's Daughter**, **Place to Beach** and **Tom's Restaurant** are all back and ready to serve up some delicious eats.

Those looking to grab some great Coney Island memorabilia to round out their day can shop at boardwalk stores and boutiques, the **Brooklyn Beach Shop** and **Lola Star** which will be open from 11am-7pm.

Live entertainment lovers are sure to enjoy themselves at the 5,000 seat **Ford Amphitheater** which will host a mix of concerts, family shows and sporting events this year ranging from rock band Coheed and Cambria to R&B legends Boyz II Men. Concert tickets are on sale now at Ticketmaster.com.

2019 will also mark the 37th year of the biggest party in Coney Island! A must-see on everyone's bucket-list, the legendary, iconic and *very* eccentric **Mermaid Parade** will fill the streets of Coney Island with mermaids and sea creatures on June 22nd as we celebrate the official start of summer. This year's King and Queen will be Arlo and Nora Guthrie, the children of the late singer-songwriter Woody Guthrie who wrote some of the most significant American folk songs such as "This Land is Your Land".

This year, even the **Coney Island YMCA** is getting in on the fun times on the Boardwalk with a 5k "Fun Run" taking place on May 11th as a warm-up to the Brooklyn Half which ends on the Riegelmann Boardwalk on May 18th. For details, visit active.com.

The amusement attractions will be open on weekends through Memorial Day, and open every day during Spring Break from April 19th to 28th. Starting Memorial Day weekend, the famed Coney Island Beach will be open to the public and amusement attractions will go into a full 7 day-a-week operation.
